

PACIFIC REGION

For operations in Pacific Ocean airspace, flight crews must report all flight level deviations of 300FT or more from the aircraft's assigned level, irrespective of the cause of the deviation.

In reporting, crews must provide the information detailed in the Assigned Altitude Deviation Report format shown in the reporting documents section of the NEWS page of this web site. Reports must be submitted to the Pacific Approvals Registry and Monitoring Organization (PARMO) by mail to:
